Gross income increased by about 15% during 2023 to €379,338 (2022 €329,630).

The 2023 increase follows a similar increase during 2022 following the easing of Covid restrictions that had been in place during 2020 and 2021. Despite the recent years' increases in gross income, the Parish is still down about 14% on gross income from where it stood in the pre-Covid year of 2019

The continuing shortfall for 2023 of -€21,832 (2022 -€32,673) is mainly due to the ongoing high energy costs.

The net spend on maintenance, repairs, decoration between ongoing and non-recurring expenditure for 2023 was €70,899 (2022 €65,366).

The Collections for the support of Priests (active and retired) go directly to the Common Fund. Our Parish well reached its target for 2023 of \in 127,166 (2022 target was \in 127,166) reflecting the continued generous support of Parishioners. We had a significant shortfall on our target for the Diocesan Services Collection of \in 38,535 requiring \in 14,454 (2022 \in 8,824) to be made up from the surplus on Common Fund.

Funds raised for Parish Building Projects are accounted for separately and periodically reported.

We thank sincerely all Parishioners for their generous support in so many ways during the past year.
